- | Official high school transcript (**sealed in business envelope from the school**).
- | Notice of acceptance by an institution of higher learning for the ensuing academic year.
- | **One** letter of recommendation in a sealed envelope with signature over the seal from a Math, English, or another core subject Teacher
- | **One** letter of recommendation in a sealed envelope with signature over the seal from someone who can speak to your community involvement and activities.
- | **Essay addressing the following topic:** “Please submit an essay to include the following: 1) how this scholarship may help you achieve your academic goals and 2) describe your current community service participation and what it means to you.”
Your essay must be 500 words or more, typewritten and double-spaced using 1” margins and 12pt. font-size.
- | One small photo with parent/guardian signed released for publicity purposes. (optional)
